#### Program Updates

Mental Health Loan Forgiveness
• House File 2549 enacted the program

- Drafting administrative rules, application, administrative processes to implement program
- First awards anticipated spring 2023
- Candidates are non-prescribing mental health practitioners serving high-need communities in lowa \$40,000 benefit for 5 years of employment

#### Loan Repayment Programs Overview

- Rural Iowa Primary Care Loan Repayment Program

  Max award \$200,000 for MD's and DO's that graduate from Des Moines University or Carver College of Medicine and practice for 5 years in rural Iowa
- Approximately 14 recipients per year

Health Care Professional Recruitment Program

- Max award \$50,000 for ARNP, athletic trainers, occupational therapists, physical therapists, physicians, PA's, podiatrists and RN's who work for 4 years in high-need communities

  Approximately 15 recipients per year

- Teach Iowa Scholar Program

  Max award \$20,000 for recent teacher graduates who teach 5 years in shortage area (world language, physics, school counselor, FCS, agriculture, etc.)
- Approximately 85 recipients per year

### Loan Repayment Programs Overview

- Rural Iowa Veterinarian Loan Repayment Program

  Max award \$60,000 for veterinarians who practice for 4 years in a veterinary shortage area or service commitment area
- Approximately 5 recipients per year

Health Care Award Program

- Max award 350,000 for registered nurses, ARNP, physician assistants and nurse educators for 5 years of service in eligible high-need areas of Iowa
  Approximately 50 recipients each year

- Mental Health Professional Loan Repayment Program

  Max award \$40,000 for 5 years of employment in high-need area as non-prescribing psychologist, counselor, social worker, marriage and family therapist or mental health counselor

  Anticipate 12 recipients each year


