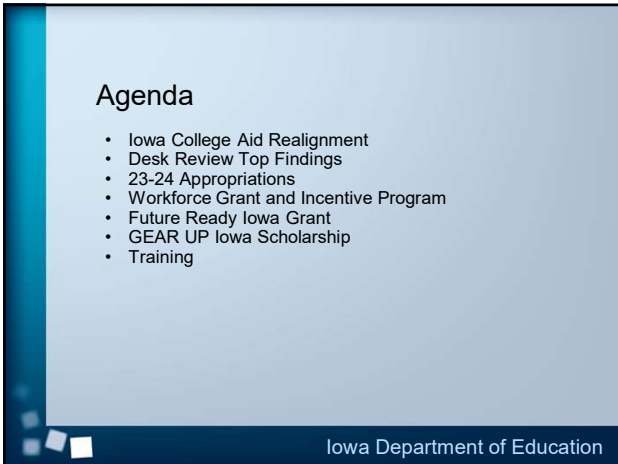
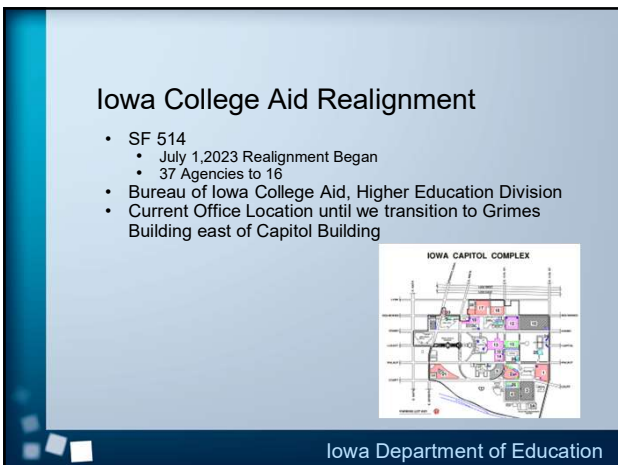

Workforce Grant & Incentive Program

- Workforce Grant
 - Students enrolled in high demand areas
 - Attending a regent university
 - Enroll in at least 3 or more semester hours
 - Maximum Award: Up to \$2,000
- Incentive Program
 - Graduate from eligible institution within the same academic year as the WG is received
 - Complete an Iowa Financial Aid Application
 - Within 6 months of graduating employed full time in high-demand job
 - After 12 consecutive months of eligible employment will receive incentive payment
 - Maximum Award TBD

Future Ready Iowa Grant


- Students enrolled in high demand areas in Bachelor Programs
- Attending a college with an eligible program
 - Regent
 - Private
 - Approved Virtual Institution
- Enroll in at least 6 credits or more unless final term
- Can receive up to 4 semesters
- Maximum Award: TBD

GEAR UP Iowa Scholarship

- Federally funded grant
 - Followed youth from 7th grade through high school
 - Scholarship component
- 23-24 Final Year of Scholarship
- Awarded GEAR UP 3.0
 - Students are in 7th grade, will provide updates as they get closer to college.
