- RECIPIENTS FROM 1ST ROUND
 - **DUAN/DNACC** - SUPPORTS EMPLOYEES OF DUAN TO PARTICIPATE IN DNACC'S EMPLOYER SPONSORED TECHNOLOGY PATHWAY PROGRAM.
 - **FOUR OAKS FAMILY & CHILDREN'S SERVICES** - ENROLL 30 YOUTH IN LINN COUNTY IN A PROGRAM TO PROVIDE SOFT SKILL TRAINING, MENTORING, AND 4-WEEK INTERNSHIPS
 - **KIRKWOOD CC & IOWA CITY-EDMAR RAPIDS (ICRIOWA)** - TARGET 60 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS TO COMPLETE POST-SECONDARY CTE CREDENTIAL
 - **NEW BOREMIAN INNOVATION COLLABORATIVE** - 10 STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS FOR A CODING PROGRAM
 - **CENTRAL COLLEGE-PELLA TALENT PIPELINE APPRENTICESHIP SCHOOL** - PROVIDES CORE CURRICULUM FOR HIGH-DEMAND OCCUPATIONS WITH A FOCUS ON WRAP AROUND SERVICES FOR INDIVIDUALS SEEKING APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITIES AFTER HIGH SCHOOL

FUTURE READY IOWA GRANT



- \$1,000,000 APPROPRIATION FOR 2019-2020
- \$3,500 FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED FULL TIME
- HAVE AT LEAST HALF OF THE CREDITS COMPLETED AND ACCEPTED TOWARD AN ELIGIBLE BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAM AT AN ELIGIBLE SCHOOL
 - WWW.FUTUREREADYIOWA.GOV/GRANT-LIST
- HAVE NOT BEEN ENROLLED IN A POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION FOR TWO OR MORE YEARS
- HAVE APPLIED FOR ALL OTHER AVAILABLE STATE AND FEDERAL AID
- FAFSA & IOWA FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION REQUIRED

FUTURE READY IOWA GRANT



- PROCESS TO DETERMINE ELIGIBLE PROGRAMS (REVIEWED ANNUALLY)
 - IOWA WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD DETERMINES ELIGIBLE CAREERS BY SOC CODE
 - IOWA COLLEGE AID DETERMINES ELIGIBLE CIP CODES FROM APPROVED SOC CODES
 - IOWA COLLEGE AID REACHES OUT TO INSTITUTIONS TO SEE IF THEY OFFER THE COURSES AND APPROVES ELIGIBLE COURSES PER SCHOOL

FUTURE READY IOWA GRANT



- DETERMINING ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS
 - IAFSA & IFAA ARE REQUIRED
 - 2019-2020
 - PRIORITY DEADLINE - AUGUST 1
 - APPLICATIONS OPEN UNTIL - DECEMBER 1, 2019
 - 2020-2021
 - PRIORITY DEADLINE - JULY 1
 - APPLICATIONS OPEN UNTIL - DECEMBER 1, 2020
 - PRIORITY GROUPS:
 1. ELIGIBLE NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS
 2. ELIGIBLE STUDENTS WITH LESS THAN 12 SEMESTER HOURS REMAINING TO COMPLETE AN ELIGIBLE PROGRAM
 3. ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS BY DATE OF SUBMISSION

FUTURE READY IOWA GRANT



- RENEWING THE FUTURE READY IOWA GRANT
 - MUST MAINTAIN CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT (ENROLLED IN AT LEAST 6 CREDIT HOURS)
 - SUMMER DOES NOT COUNT TOWARD CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT
 - 6 CREDIT HOUR MINIMUM TO RECEIVE GRANT IN SUMMER
 - MAXIMUM LIFETIME LIMIT: 2 POINTS
 - 4 FULL-TIME SEMESTERS
 - 8 PART-TIME SEMESTERS

FUTURE READY IOWA GRANT



- INSTITUTION MUST REQUIRE STUDENTS TO:
 - ATTEND AND ORIENTATION SESSION, IN-PERSON OR VIRTUALLY, FOR THE ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION;
 - REGISTER FOR COURSES WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF AN ADVISOR AND PARTICIPATE IN AVAILABLE ACADEMIC ADVISING SESSIONS;
 - CREATE A GRADUATION PLAN IF REQUIRED IN THE PROGRAM OF STUDY;
 - PARTICIPATE IN AVAILABLE CAREER ADVISING SESSIONS IF REQUIRED IN THE PROGRAM OF STUDY, INCLUDING CREATION OF A CAREER PLAN WHEN POSSIBLE.
- INSTITUTIONS MUST:
 - NOTIFY ELIGIBLE STUDENTS OF THE VOLUNTEER MENTOR PROGRAM IN THE FINANCIAL AID AWARD LETTER/PACKET;
 - MARKET ELIGIBLE FUTURE READY IOWA PROGRAMS OF STUDY ON THE INSTITUTION'S WEBSITE;
 - REPORT INFORMATION ANNUALLY TO IOWA COLLEGE AID.

FUTURE READY IOWA LAST-DOLLAR SCHOLARSHIP



- \$13,004,744 APPROPRIATION 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR
- COVERS COMMUNITY COLLEGE TUITION AND INSTITUTION-WIDE FEES AFTER OTHER FEDERAL AND STATE AID HAVE BEEN APPLIED, MINIMUM AMOUNT AVAILABLE
- ENROLLED IN CERTAIN CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS LEADING TOWARDS A HIGH DEMAND CAREER

- ASSOCIATE DEGREE OR BELOW (TITLE IN ELIGIBLE) AT AN ELIGIBLE COLLEGE

- HAVE APPLIED FOR ALL OTHER AVAILABLE STATE AND FEDERAL AID
- FAFSA REQUIRED

 - STATEWIDE LIST:
 - IOWA WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD DETERMINES ELIGIBLE CAREERS BY SOC CODE
 - IOWA COLLEGE AID DETERMINES ELIGIBLE CIP CODES FROM APPROVED SOC CODES
 - REGIONAL LIST:
 - IOWA COMMUNITY COLLEGES WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION DETERMINES REGIONAL CHOICES BASED ON SOC CODE
 - IOWA COLLEGE AID DETERMINES ELIGIBLE CIP CODES FROM APPROVED SOC CODES

FUTURE READY IOWA LAST-DOLLAR SCHOLARSHIP



- **COMMON ISSUES**
 - NOT PRORATING MINIMUM AMOUNT FOR LESS-THAN FULL TIME
 - ENROLLMENT STATUS IN ICAPS NOT MATCHING AMOUNT AWARDED
 - AWARDED STUDENT NOT CERTIFIED

FUTURE READY IOWA LAST-DOLLAR SCHOLARSHIP



- INSTITUTION MUST REQUIRE STUDENTS TO:
 - ATTEND AND ORIENTATION SESSION, IN-PERSON OR VIRTUALLY, FOR THE ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION;
 - REGISTER FOR COURSES WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF AN ADVISOR AND PARTICIPATE IN AVAILABLE ACADEMIC ADVISING SESSIONS;
 - CREATE A GRADUATION PLAN IF REQUIRED IN THE PROGRAM OF STUDY;
 - PARTICIPATE IN AVAILABLE CAREER ADVISING SESSIONS IF REQUIRED IN THE PROGRAM OF STUDY INCLUDING CREATION OF A CAREER PLAN WHEN POSSIBLE.
- INSTITUTIONS MUST:
 - NOTIFY ELIGIBLE STUDENTS OF THE VOLUNTEER MENTOR PROGRAM IN THE FINANCIAL AID AWARD LETTER/PACKET;
 - FACILITATE CONNECTIONS THROUGH CAMPUS CAREER CENTERS AND SERVICES TO INTERNSHIPS AND SIMILAR LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL PROGRAMS
 - MARKET ELIGIBLE FUTURE READY IOWA PROGRAMS OF STUDY ON THE INSTITUTION'S WEBSITE;
 - REPORT INFORMATION ANNUALLY TO IOWA COLLEGE AID.
